During the month of October, Deanery Meetings were held in Enniscorthy, Wexford, Gorey and New Ross. 111 priests and people attended from parishes and curacies.

Bishop Brennan spoke about the purpose of the meetings, the reducing number of priests and their implications this would have for the pastoral care of people and the administration of parish areas.

Msgr Joe McGrath gave a presentation outlining the reduction of the number of priests working in the Diocese over recent years and the implications of this going forward.

The topic was then opened to the floor. Two proposals were then put to the meetings;

- That in the event of a Parish vacancy arising and no priest being available to fill it on a residential basis, a neighbouring priest would be appointed Administrator and would be assisted by the other priests of the Pastoral Area.
- In the light of falling Mass attendance and to facilitate the likely need in future to take responsibility for vacant parishes, weekend Masses be reduced.

After discussions and clarifications, both proposals were approved at each Deanery Meeting. These issues will now be progressed in consultation with the Priests and their Parish/Pastoral Councils.
