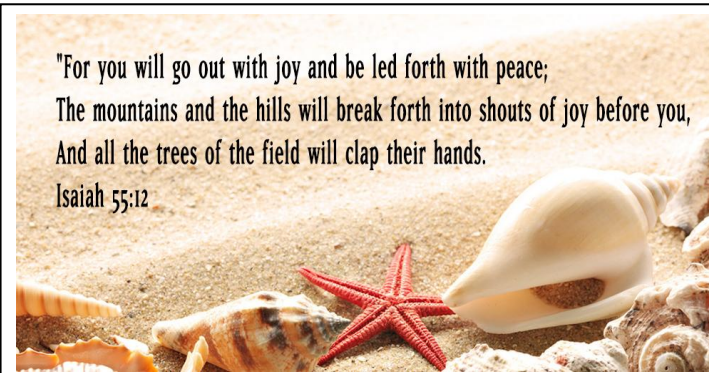
## July 3 (9pm) Summer Seisiún @ The Sky & The Ground, Wexford.
